CARE & MAINTENANCE

Daily cleaning is the simplest way to keep QSTONE shiny and radiantly beautiful for years.

For general cleaning use a damp cloth with all purpose cleaner or spray Brilliantize® on the surface and then, rub gently with a microfibre cloth.

Specialised dealers also have specific maintenance products for quartz composites available (e.g. LITHOFIN Easy Clean).

Stubborn stains can usually be removed by applying undiluted CIF CREAM with a soft sponge. Rub forcefully on the stain and rinse with sufficient amounts of clean, warm water.

Spilled drinks or stain agents from food such as tea or red wine, should be cleaned off as quickly as possible. They are more difficult to remove if they have dried. If the stone is exposed to other strong staining agents immediately clean the surface and do not allow them to dry.

Stains should be dealt with urgently as the longer the exposure the greater the chance of permanent damage.

Materials that harden after drying such as chewing gum or mustard, should first be scraped off using a blunt, plastic scraper. The area should then be cleaned as per above described and rinsed with clean water.

QSTONE is a non-porous surface so it does not need sealing and it will retain its gloss and smooth finish without polishing it.

Before applying, it is advisable to test the cleaning product on a non-visible area first.



CHEMICAL RESISTANCE

The following reagents show no permanent effect on sheets when left in contact for periods of 12 hours. These chemical residues can be removed with a wet light duty Scotch-Brite sponge and a non-abrasive cleaner such as Brillianize®.

PLEASE DO NOT

- Place any hot objects, pots or trays straight from the cooker or the oven onto the surface, always use a trivet or a hot pad
- Use scourers and abrasive cleaners
- Use waxes and polishes
- Use strongly acidic, alkaline cleaners such as oven cleaners or bleach for normal cleaning
- Handle artificial dyes, hair colouring or solvent based inks on the quartz stone
- Stand on the surface or put excessive weight on it
- Use on outdoor areas as the sun can cause discolouration
